FGS Dress Code Policy

Students are expected to dress in a clean, neat, and appropriate manner.

- Appropriate clothing will cover all undergarments and midriff;
- Sleeveless tops with straps over the shoulder or around the neck is considered appropriate;
- Shorts and skirts are to have a minimum 2" inseam; within reason and appropriate to the age of the student;
- Clothing with offensive words, slogans or pictures are considered inappropriate. Clothing displaying slogans or pictures of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, sexual, racial or violent overtones will not be permitted;
- Hoods are to be removed when entering the building, not up in classrooms;
- Dressing according to the weather is encouraged. Except for inappropriate weather conditions, students are expected to go outside for recess (Grades K to 6) and noon (Grades K to 6);
- Students neglecting to wear footwear inside could find it extremely cold or wet in the event of a school evacuation;
- All students are to wear running shoes for Physical Education classes;
- Flip Flops are not appropriate for outdoor footwear;
- Gym clothing is required in upper grades but does not have to strictly adhere to the dress code fit guidelines as long as it is deemed appropriate by the phys. ed teacher;
- Students seen wearing inappropriate clothing will be asked to change into their phys. ed attire, if it is appropriate for the classroom, turn offensive clothing inside out, return home to change, or call parents to bring appropriate clothing;
- Student will not be able to attend class until the perceived dress code violation has been addressed.
